## **Audit for Fiscal Year Ending 9-30-2020**

As soon as I am able to close the books for this past fiscal year we will begin the new audit.

#### **FEMA CLAIMS**

The buildings claim for the pool house has been funded with mitigation. The budget amendment reflects the funding.

The DAC (Direct Admin Costs) from Harvey is on hold until we can provide the number of hours worked. We were originally told that FEMA would just pay a percentage of our total claim but now they want hours. I will be working on that.

Now that the road paving project will be complete this week, we will request reimbursement from FEMA for the Harvey Road Claim. These funds will be reimbursing our CO Funds as they have already been expended from that account. I do not have an amount for the claim yet. There will be remaining funds to be claimed when road work is done in Section 4 with the Developer.

## **Streetlights in Section 4 and Park**

Mr. Thornberry is working with Entergy to get street lighting in Section 4. The streetlights on the boulevard will be added to the city's monthly Entergy bill for the cost of the electricity.
