

ORDINANCE NO. 533-20

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ROMAN FOREST, TEXAS AMENDING THE CITY'S OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021, AS PREVIOUSLY APPROVED IN BUDGET ORDINANCE NUMBER 532-20, DATED SEPTEMBER 15, 2020; PROVIDING A TEXAS OPEN MEETINGS CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THE AMENDED BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City of Roman Forest City Council approved the City's Operating Budget for the fiscal year 2020-2021 by Ordinance No. 532-20, dated September 15, 2020, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the budget amendments are necessary for (1) allocating unused expenses in the prior fiscal year, (2) additional FEMA funding from Harvey Disaster 4332, (3) the Conduit Sale proceeds for Colleyville Covenant Christian Academy, all of which are specifically referenced in the attached Amended Operating Budget; and

WHEREAS, the proposed budget as amended appears satisfactory; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds the amendment is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Roman Forest, Texas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROMAN FOREST, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: The facts and recitations set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct.


SECTION 2: City Ordinance 532-20, dated September 15, 2020, is hereby amended.

SECTION 3: The City of Roman Forest's operating budget for the fiscal year 2020-2021, as amended hereto, is hereby approved and accepted.



SECTION 5: This Ordinance and the amended budget shall become effective upon passage by the Roman Forest City Council and publication as provided by law.

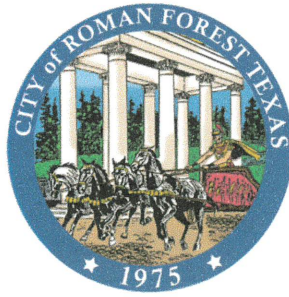
